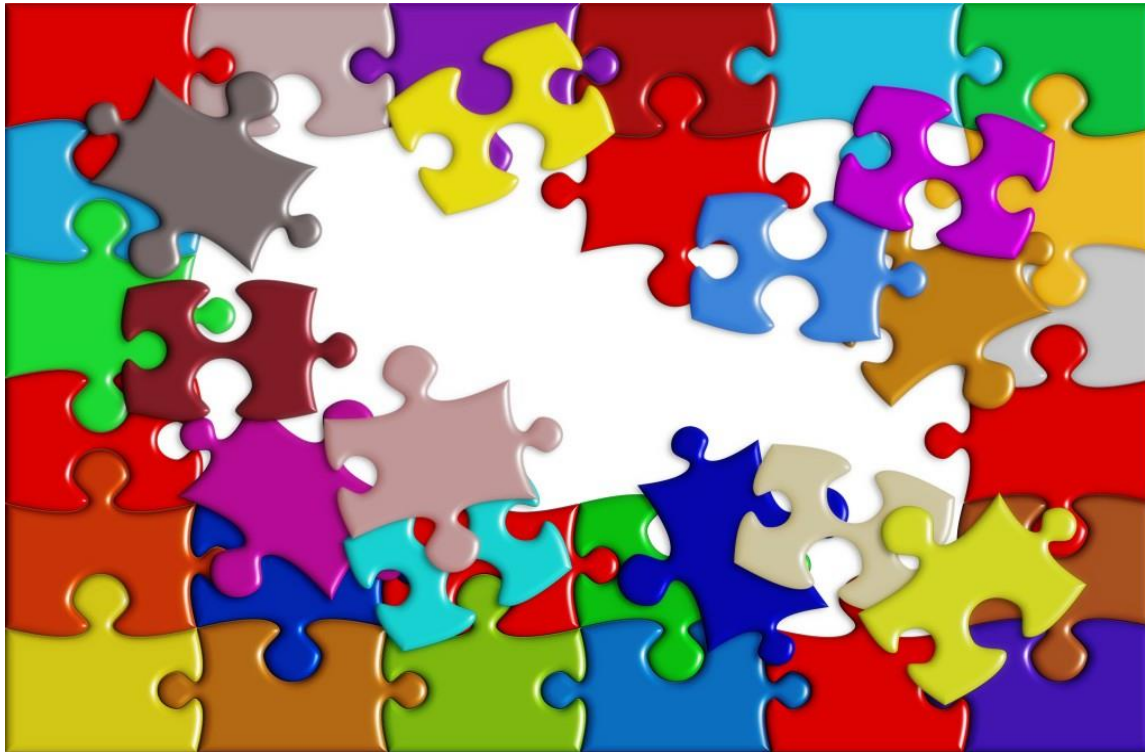

# Policy- Prudence



## Prudent healthcare

is built around a set of 5 principles, which state that any service or person providing care should:

Do no **HARM**



Carry out the **MINIMUM APPROPRIATE INTERVENTION**



Organise the workforce around the **"ONLY DO, WHAT ONLY YOU CAN DO"** principle

Promote **EQUITY**



Remodel the relationship between user and provider on the basis of **CO-PRODUCTION**
