Asthma Audit Development Project (AADP)

The AADP is working to prepare for a National Asthma Audit. It is developing a set of questions (datasets) which all hospitals will be required to answer as part of the audit.

The questions will assess how well asthma patients admitted to hospital are treated and make sure the treatment and advice they receive meets asthma standards and guidelines.

AADP hospital pilot

Between 11 September and 9 October 2017 this hospital will be collecting information about patients admitted to this hospital with an asthma flare-up (attack) and the care they receive to pilot (test) these questions. No confidential information will be collected.
