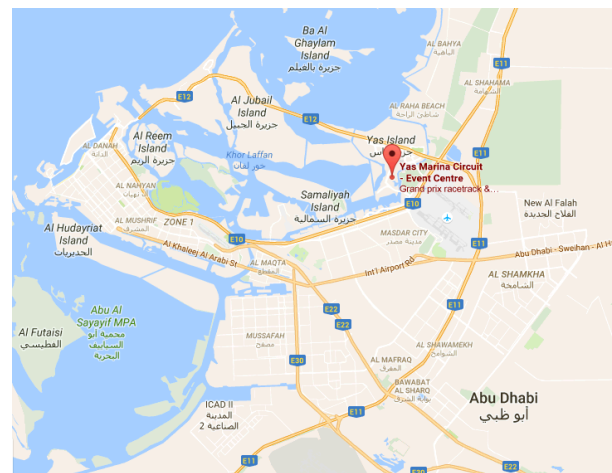
BY CAR

- Once on the island, road signage will direct you to Yas Marina Circuit.



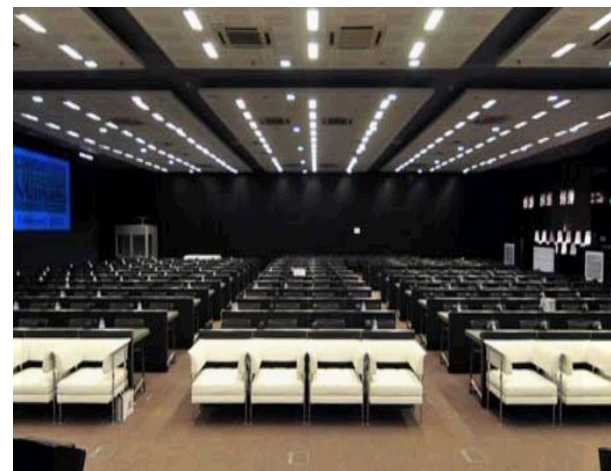
BY BUS
