

RCP virtual poster competition

Eligibility checklist

The lead author must meet ALL of the criteria below to be eligible to apply.

Applications will be verified and rejected if the criteria are not met.

☐ I am a resident doctor working in a [RCP recognised medical specialty](#) in the UK. This only permits the following to apply:

- international medical graduates, foundation doctors, internal medicine trainees (IMT)
 - higher specialty trainees (HST) and MTI doctors
 - medical students
 - locally employed doctors working at an equivalent level to those in training, for example, clinical fellows and senior clinical fellows.
 - doctors in a HST post (or a locally employed equivalent) working in an [RCP recognised medical specialty](#).
 - public health resident doctors will be accepted if a subscribing member of the RCP
- This competition is NOT open to surgical trainees and submissions from medicine trainees must not relate to surgical projects. Applications from

Group submissions are accepted, but a lead author must be identified and must submit the application. All other authors must be named as a co-author on the application (maximum of 3). Only those co-authors named on the submitted application will be named on the certificates we issue (to shortlisted abstracts). Co-authors do not need to be an RCP member but MUST meet all other criteria. Consultants must not be named as a co-author but can be referenced on the poster, should your abstract be shortlisted to present in the next stage of the competition.
